qualifying foreign citizen and not require leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom
or have indefinite leave to remain. You must be 18 years of age or over; and meet at
least one of the following criteria:
 registered as a local government elector for the area named above; or
 during the whole of the last 12 months occupied as owner or tenant land or other
premises in the community named above; or
 your principal or only place of work during the last 12 months has been in the
community named above; or
 you have during the whole of the last 12 months resided in the Community or
within 4.8 kilometres of it. ¹
